## SCHEDULE

Coaches meeting from 9:00pm - 10:00pm at the Kellogg Center Boardroom. Coaches and chefs de mission must attend. Interested athletes may attend. Obtain relay cards at this time.

Check the shuttle bus schedule in Athlete Village. Athletes are responsible for arriving at Mason High School on time for check-in. Athletes have priority when boarding the shuttle buses.

## LOCATION/VENUE

Mason High School Aquatic Center, 1001 South Barnes Street, Mason, MI 48854. The 8-lane, 25-meter swimming pool was constructed in 2005. This facility boasts modern starting blocks, lane lines, and automatic timing equipment, and is fully accessible according to the standards of the Americans with Disabilities Act. Lockers are available, but swimmers should bring their own padlocks. There is ample spectator seating and parking.

## TRANSPORTATION

Shuttle bus transportation will be available to and from the Athlete Village and the Mason High School Aquatic Center. Swimmers shall have priority in boarding the buses. People who did not register for the games as either athletes or non-athletes may not ride the shuttle buses. Bus schedules, maps, and related information will be available at Athlete Village.

## RULES

- IDAF rules (<http://www.2013WorldDwarfGames.org/PDF/Rules.pdf>) will be observed. Swimmers, coaches, and chefs de mission should be familiar with Parts 1 through 3 and Part 13 of the IDAF rule book.
- Spectators are not allowed on the field of play (swimming pool deck).

- Entries:
  - Swimmers may enter a maximum of four individual events and one relay.
  - Per IDAF rules, males and females from different ages and classifications may be seeded together for efficiency; however, separate results and awards will be maintained. We plan to combine the following events for seeding purposes: 15+16+17, 19+20, 23+25, 38+39+40, 41+42, 43+44, 47+48, 61+62, 70+71, and 72+74.
  - Classifications are noted on psych sheets and heat sheets by the number in front of the country code. Classifications do not apply to futures or flotation events.
  - Futures who enter the 12.5m flotation event may NOT also enter the 12.5m freestyle event. Futures and juniors who enter the 25m flotation event may NOT also enter the 25m freestyle event.
- Relays:
  - Juniors 4 x 25m freestyle relays may include any combination of boys or girls aged 7-15 years in any order. There are separate Open 4 x 50m relays for men and women.
  - Per Michigan public health laws, the second and fourth swimmers on the Juniors 4 x 25m freestyle relay will start in the water because of shallow water depth at that end of the pool.
  - Relays will be entered either at the coach's meeting on Saturday, August 3, or at the pool before Event #37. Chefs de mission or swim coaches should pick up blank relay cards at the coach's meeting. Mixed-country teams are welcome!

## START LISTS AND CHECK-IN

- **Preliminary start lists.** Preliminary start lists showing the swimmers entered in each event will be sent to chefs de mission prior to the games and will be posted at Athlete Village.
- **Swimming check-in desk at the Mason High School Aquatic Center**
  - **Credentials.** Athletes must wear their World Dwarf Games credentials when reporting to check-in and also when staging for each of their events.
  - **Individual check-in.** Swimmers must check-in immediately upon arrival at the Mason High School Aquatic Center. Swimmers who have not checked in by 4:15

pm will be dropped from their events. Swimmers may drop events at check-in, but may not add events.

- **Relay check-in.** Chefs de mission or head swimming coaches must confirm relay entries before the start of Event #37, including the names, ages, and order of relay swimmers.
- **Final start lists.** Final start lists showing heat and lane assignments for individual events will be available to chefs de mission and head coaches at the coach's meeting on Saturday, August 3. Copies will also be posted around the swimming pool and spectator areas. Heat and lane assignments for relay teams will be available at staging immediately prior to the start of Events #71 and #72.

## **STAGING**

Swimmers must report to the swimming staging area about 10 minutes (4 event numbers) prior to the start of their events. All four members of a relay team must report together for staging.

## **RESULTS AND AWARDS**

Results will be posted on the 2013 World Dwarf Games web site, posted at Athlete Village, and distributed to chefs de mission in their Athlete Village mailboxes. Awards for swimming events will be presented at the Mason High School Aquatics Center. At awards presentations, athletes are expected to wear the uniforms designated by their nations' dwarf sports organizations.

## **FOOD AND BEVERAGES**

Food will be available at the swimming meet for persons who have purchased meal plans at Athlete Village. A concession stand with food/beverages for sale will be available at the meet for persons who did not purchase meal plans.
